Supervisor Sharon Bronson to dedicate new Picture Rocks pool

Pima County Supervisor Sharon Bronson will dedicate the new Picture Rocks pool on Saturday, May 19. The ribbon-cutting ceremony will take place at 9am on the pool deck, located at 5615 N. Sanders Road in Picture Rocks.

“One of the best ways for the Picture Rocks community to beat the heat this summer will be to come out and enjoy this beautiful new pool,” said Bronson. “Summers are for fun and relaxation, and this is an activity that the whole family can enjoy.”

After the ribbon-cutting, the pool will remain open for a free swim until noon on Saturday. The Picture Rocks pool will officially open over Memorial Day weekend, on Saturday, May 26.

Background:

Pima County voters overwhelmingly approved the pool project as part of the 2004 Pima County bond package. Burns Wald-Hopkins Architects designed the pool to serve all segments of the diverse Picture Rocks community, as well as to maximize the \$2 million investment. The pool area includes a splash pad for water toys, shade cabanas, and a turf picnic area with shade trees.

Regular hours of operation for the pool are Monday through Thursday, 1:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. for “Open Recreational Swims” at a cost of \$0.50 for children and \$1.50 for adults. The pool will be open Saturdays and Sundays for “Family Swims” from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. for \$1.00 per family. Pima County pools are closed on Fridays. Swim lessons will be available in two-week sessions at a cost of \$20.
