Supervisor Bronson to celebrate completion of new Ajo Community Golf Course roof

Tucson, Ariz. – The Ajo Golf Course is receiving a new clubhouse roof, thanks to Pima County Supervisor Sharon Bronson’s efforts securing supplemental Parks and Recreation funds for the project. The clubhouse roof has needed to be replaced for years, but no money has been available in the golf course budget for such a major project.

“The entire community of Ajo benefits from the golf course,” said Bronson. “The clubhouse is not just a meeting place for members of the community; it is also a draw for tourists and travelers. The Ajo Golf Course is a real economic asset for the town, and I’m glad to see these long-awaited renovations finally taking place.”

The new clubhouse roof cost \$105,000, which came from Pima County’s general fund after a supplemental request from Pima County Parks and Recreation.

Bronson will be in Ajo on April 20 at the dedication ceremony for the clubhouse roof. The ceremony will take place at 2pm at the clubhouse, 77 Mead Road in Ajo.

Supervisor Bronson was elected to the Pima County Board of Supervisors in 1996. She represents District 3, the largest of the five supervisorial districts and the only district sharing more than 100 miles of international border with Mexico. Bronson served as Chair of the Board until 2006, and is currently co-chair of TREO, Tucson Region Economic Opportunities, Inc.
